

Pupil Premium spending report for 2017-2018

Interventions used and analysis of them:

Interventions are reviewed on a half termly basis. This is done through the use of assessment data and through 'raising standards' meetings. Some interventions for this academic year include;

Activity	Department	Cost	Impact
Better reader/accelerated reader	English	£6,500	All students in Years 7-9 are involved in the Accelerated Reader Programme to boost literacy levels and those in needs of additional support identified through Key Stage 2 SATs, Reading and Spelling Ages are offered additional support more intensive support with the Better Reading Scheme. Year 7 - 75% growth in their Reading Age, Year 8 - 92% growth in their Reading Age, Year 9 had 87% growth in their Reading Age. The need for intervention can be identified through the scheme. Those students were then able to be put on an urgent intervention program.
Tuition	Music	£7,300	50% of PP students taking BTEC music in Year 11 achieved Distinction* grade.
Supplies/materials/sketch books/art workshop/food ingredients	Art/Technology	£500	Improved engagement and less issues with behaviour as a result of being able to take part fully in lessons.
Trips including university and careers advice and guidance	Various	£1,150	Various trips for PP students to help access the curriculum in a number of subjects. Feedback from PP students through surveys showed that they valued trips and thought they helped with career advice particularly.
Scholars club Year 8 and 10	Supracurricular	£3840	10 students from year 8 and 10 respectively completed the scholars programme of university style tuition. Students reported an increase in aspiration and resilience. 75% of students achieved a 1 st or 2:1 grade in their final assignment.
Student passports	N/a	£500	Form tutors created student passports based on interviews with PP students. This was circulated to class teachers, so they were aware of issues and strategies to support students.
Uniform	N/A	£900	Uniform provided for new Year 7 PP students. PE uniform purchased so students could take part fully in lessons. Attendance in year 7 for PP students the same as non-PP.

Adastra tuition	English, Maths and Science	£12,000	57% of students who took part exceeded teacher predictions in their GCSE's. 10 Year 11 students identified by the English department as being below target have 1 ½ hours a week tuition for 5 months leading up to their GCSE exam. 57% of students who took part were on or above target in their GCSE's. 10 Year 11 students identified by the Maths department as being below target have 1 ½ hours a week tuition for 5 months leading up to their GCSE exam. Consistent attendance all students improved on their levels from the start of the programme and 80% students achieved their aspirational target.
Taxi to extra revision sessions	English/Maths	£100	Taxi for 2 students targeted by the school to attend afterschool and half term revision sessions. This meant students who were able to attend intervention sessions when they otherwise would not have been. 1 of these students achieved 100% 5-9.
Text books and revision guides	Various	£1,000	Students studying GCSE subjects who need revision guides and or text books to help with revision. These were provided to most PP students across all GCSE and BTEC subjects where staff felt they were needed.
Breakfast before exams	N/A	£1,000	Research shows students concentration is improved by having breakfast.
Mental health online workshop	N/A	£180	Support with student's mental health and e-safety.
Peer mentor training	6 th form	£1,500	Training for 6 th form students to become mentors for students in Years 7-11 and support them with organisation, homework and revision.
Adviza careers advice	N/A	£5,000	Pupil premium students get access to careers advice and guidance to help with the choices they make when they leave school. This includes specialised workshops and presentations.
Translation services	N/A	£500	Vital report documents and other communication from school is translated where necessary to ensure all parents can access the information.
