

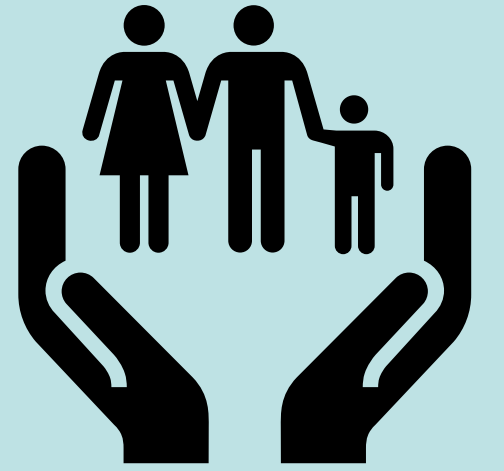


# Safeguarding @ SWR

- Protect you from harm
- Make sure nothing stops you from being happy
- Make sure you are safely looked after
- Make sure you have the best life chances



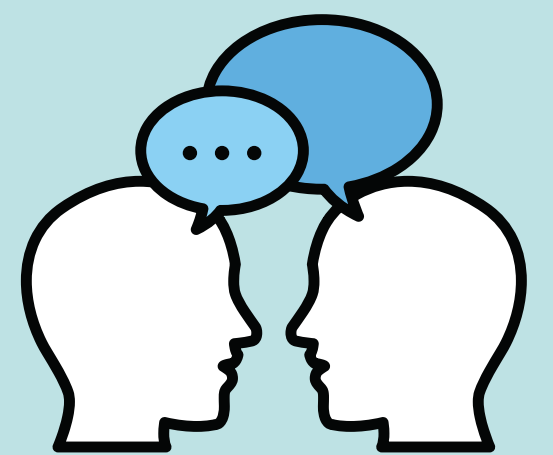
## What kinds of things might make me feel unsafe?

- Being hurt by an adult or another child
- Being touched in a way you don't like
- Not being looked after by people at home
- Seeing people you love being hurt



## If you see or hear something that doesn't feel right

- Tell an adult in school or speak to one of the safeguarding team
- Tell an adult at home
- Tell a friend



## Staff, Governors and volunteers at the school

Before someone new comes to work or volunteer at our school we have in place strict checks to ensure they are suitable to work with children.

All staff receive regular training in safeguarding and child protection.
