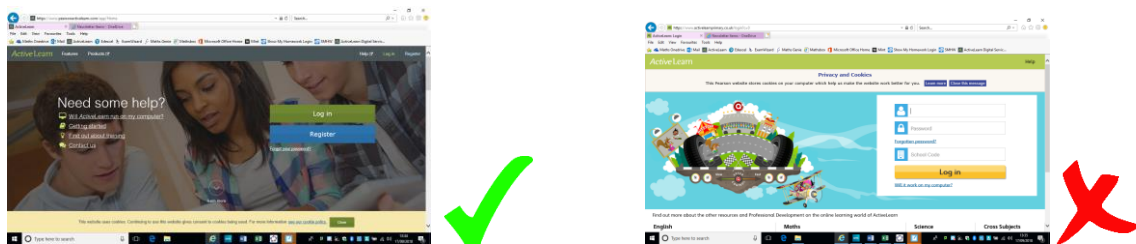


## Pearson Activelearn

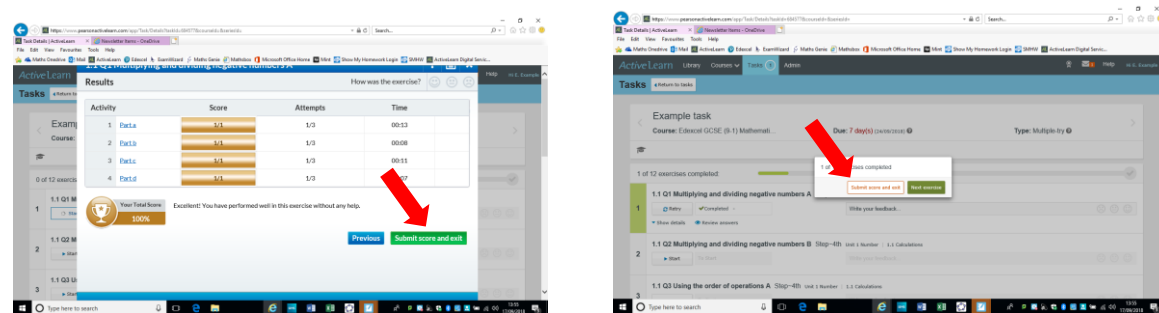
As part of his/her homework, the Mathematics Department will set your child a combination of written and online work. Online homework will be set through the platform of Pearson Activelearn and may be set on current or previously learned topic with the aim of consolidating current work and improving the recall of previously learned topics.

The login page for Pearson Activelearn is <https://www.pearsonactivelearn.com/app/Home> . Please ensure that you log in using this web page. If you are asked for a school code, then you are trying to access through the wrong web page.

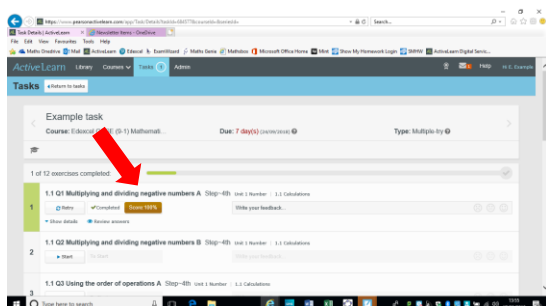


If your child was a student at Sir William Ramsay last year, they will already have an Activelearn username but will be given the new password. If your child has joined the school recently, they will be given an Activelearn username and password by their maths teacher. The usernames are not case-sensitive, but the password is.

When your child has logged in they can access their tasks using the 'Tasks' tabs at the top of the page. When they have finished a task, it is really important that they submit their score and exit.



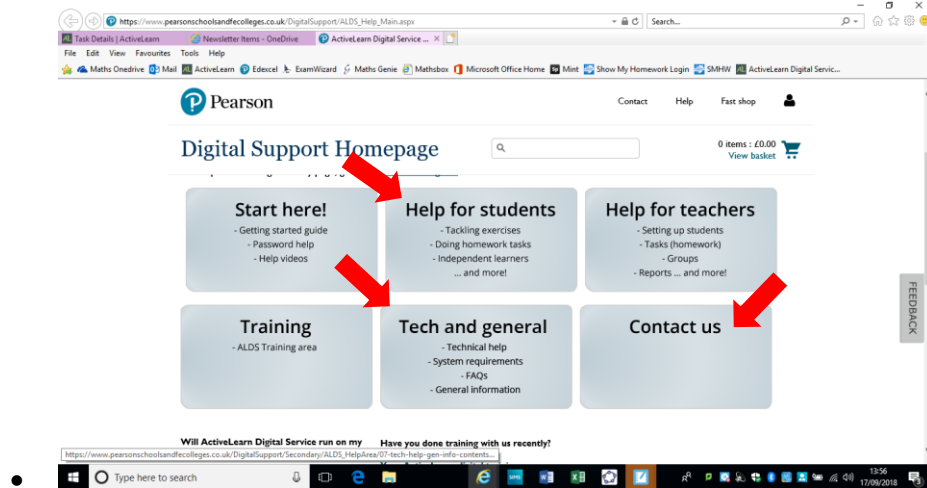
If the score has saved successfully, the percentage will be displayed, as below.
