



Face Coverings at Sir William Ramsay School

In light of the [Government guidance](#) published on 26th August students, staff and visitors will be required to wear a face mask (not a face covering) when in communal indoor areas (eg. Corridors). This does NOT include classrooms – face mask will not be worn in classrooms as they impede on teaching and learning.

Students, staff and visitors will be required to remove their mask on entering a classroom and sanitise their hands. They will replace their mask on leaving the classroom. Safe masks must be stored safely when not being worn in a sealable, plastic bag.

It is a legal requirement for anyone over the age of 11 to wear a face covering whilst on public transport and is strongly encouraged when using dedicated transport (school buses). At the end of the school day, students who get a bus home will be required to line up in their year group bubble at the front of school, they will not be allowed onto the bus until they have a mask on.
