



Impact of the Year 7 Catch Up Premium 2019/20

<p>Better Reader /Accelerated Reader</p> <p>All students in Years 7-9 are involved in the Accelerated Reader Programme to boost literacy levels.</p> <p>Those in need of additional support identified through Key Stage 2 SATs are offered additional support/more intensive support with the Better Reading Scheme. The need for intervention can be identified through the scheme. Those students are then able to be put on an urgent intervention program.</p>	<p>Ongoing cost</p>	<p>Students were tested over a period of four months.</p> <p>Accelerated Reader Programme: Year7</p> <p>109 /182 (59.89%) students taking part in the Accelerated Reader Scheme improved on their reading age with an average growth in their reading age of 5 months.</p> <p>90 students showed growth greater than 4 months (chronological).</p> <p>Better Reading Scheme: 10 /15 of students with a reading age below their chronological age participated in the Better Reading Programme and improved on their reading age.</p> <p>Average growth overall (15 students) was 6 months from 8:03 to 8:09.</p> <p>Average growth over the 10 students was 11 months from 8:02 to 9:01</p>
<p>Literacy and Numeracy Intervention programme</p>	<p>£20,807</p>	<p>Qualified teachers are used to deliver Structured interventions, delivered in small groups, support students who have fallen behind furthest. There is extensive evidence showing the long-term negative impact of beginning secondary school without secure literacy skills.</p> <p>Literacy Catch Up: 16/24 of the students targeted for literacy intervention are working on or above target.</p>

		<p>8/24 students were working towards their target.</p> <p>Numeracy Catch Up: Overall, all the students who did not achieve the expected standard in Key Stage 2 maths and were given additional support are on track to reach their target.</p>
